A junior is classed as anyone under 18 or still in full time education (proof will be required), and the joining fee is waived until the member becomes a senior. The joining fee is NOT refundable, except in the case of the full membership not being accepted after the probationary period.

It is a requirement that all Teesside Model Flying Club members must be registered with the CAA and be a member of the British Model Flying Association, BMFA, who run our accreditation scheme, and provide liability insurance. Members can organise their own BMFA membership, or the club will arrange it provided the appropriate BMFA fee is included. No member will be allowed to fly until they are able to provide proof of BMFA membership if they arrange it themselves. Members from other model flying clubs who have already paid BMFA fees do not need to pay this fee again if joining Teesside Model Flying Club.

Family membership is available to family members living at the same address. To qualify for Family membership, one full Senior member must register as Head of Family; a spouse/partner and all children under 18 years old can then register as Family members at a reduced fee.

The normal period of membership shall be from 1st January to 31st December in each year. Reduced BMFA fees are available from 1st July. If applying after 1st July, please check the BMFA website for the reduced rates. There is no reduced rate for TMFC membership if joining later in the year.

15-mile limit

This is defined as the direct distance between the applicant's permanent residence and the centre of the Redmarshall field. As a guide this includes Easington to the north, as far north west as Mount Joy on the south-east border of Durham City, the centre of Willington, the eastern edge of High Enderby, Gainford, Scotch Corner, the crossroads in Brompton (near, but not including Northallerton), Osmotherley, Battersby, Guisborough, and the area of Marske to the west of the A1085.
